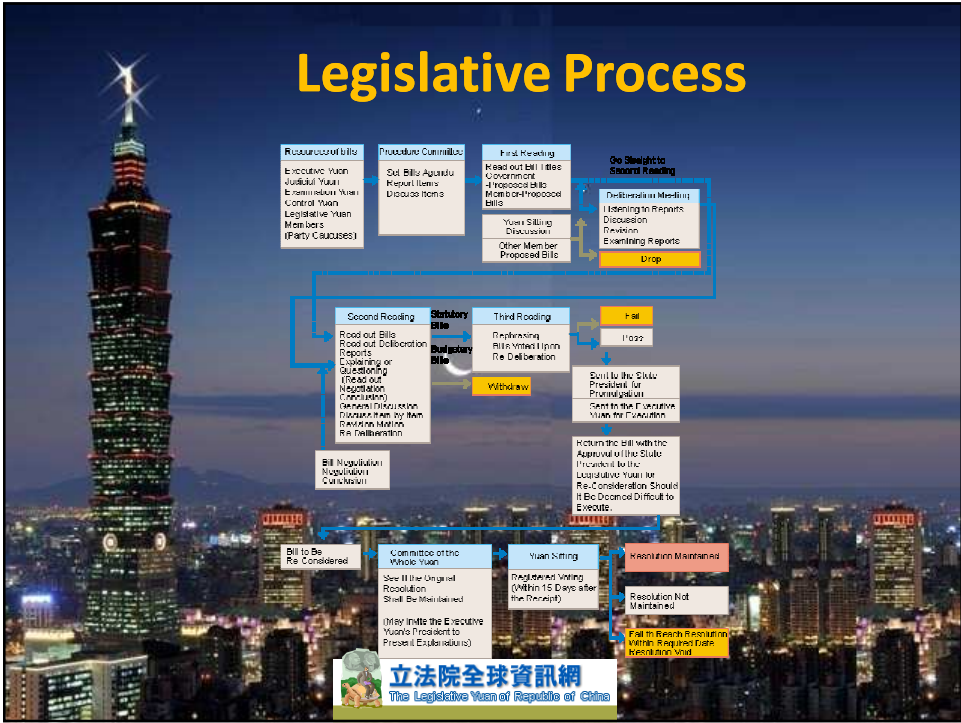

- A Qualifying Process including the academic preparation, clinical experience, and Examinations were established.



## Brief History

- 1999
  - Radiation therapy medical physics.
- 2000
  - Radiation dosimetrist .
- 2003
  - MOC (maintenance of certification, 5-year)
- 2007
  - Diagnostic imaging medical physics .



## After 11 years

- Is widely recognized by the medical community in Taiwan even without government sanction.
- From 2014 all hospital in Taiwan applying for radiation oncology residency training program must show that they have qualified medical physicists on staff

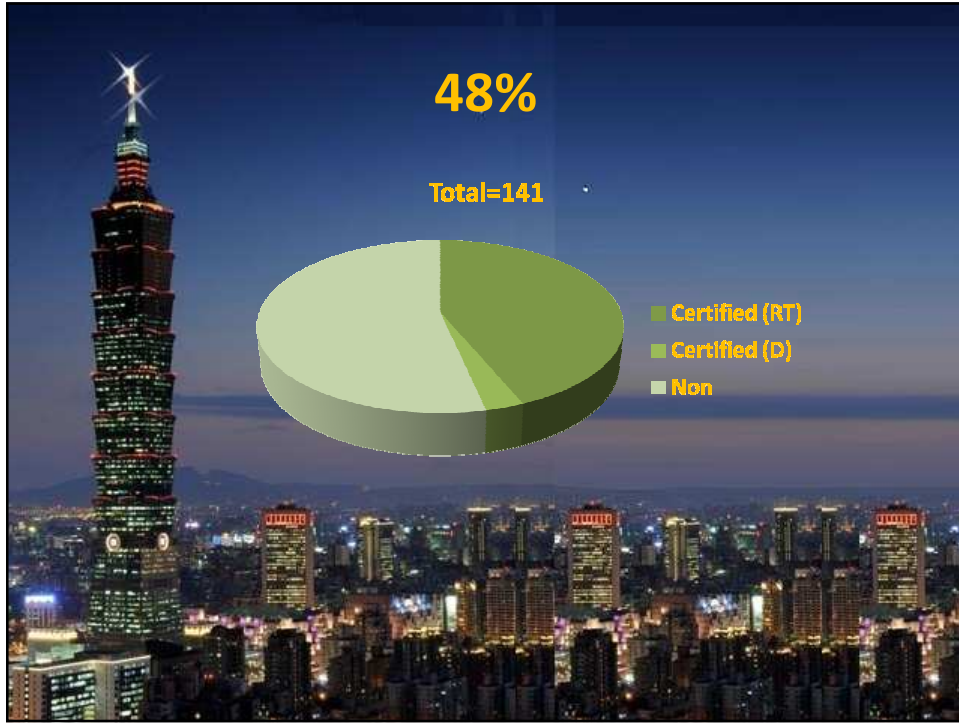
